## The Association of Anaesthetists is looking to appoint a new Executive Editor for *Anaesthesia Reports*

The Association of Anaesthetists launched a fully independent case report journal, *Anaesthesia Reports*, in January 2019. This journal has now been PubMed listed and continues to thrive. The term of office of the current Executive Editor is ending, and therefore the Association of Anaesthetists is looking to appoint a new Executive Editor. The role is primarily email and web-based, but also requires attendance at Editorial Board meetings and in-person promotion of the Journal. The role involves communication, decision-making, reviewing submitted manuscripts and multimedia items and editing, as well as raising the profile of the Journal. The successful applicant should have a history of editing and publication, excellent written and spoken English language skills, strong strategic and leadership skills and exceptional time management. Previous editorial experience is required. The term of office is two years with up to two extensions. The honorarium for this office is £4700 per annum.

As well as the opportunity to work with an excellent and cohesive editorial team, rewards include free registration at major Association of Anaesthetists' meetings.

Applicants should submit a statement of up to 500 words on the subject of 'Future steps in developing *Anaesthesia Reports*' to [anaesthesia@anaesthetists.org](mailto:anaesthesia@anaesthetists.org), together with a short CV (no more than two A4 pages) and a cover letter justifying their application. Shortlisted candidates may be asked to perform editorial tasks and/or attend an interview as part of the selection process.
